General Things to Remember When Moving Overseas

Initially, your checklist before moving out must include the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Consider what to do with your possessions.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Orient your family about your move.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask each family member to make their personal checklists.

General Other Things to Do Before the Move

Three-Months-Before-Moving-to-a-Foreign-Country Checklist

<input type="checkbox"/>	Get to know your host country: 1. Research about the local culture 2. Prepare all required documents
<input type="checkbox"/>	Get quotes from international moving companies. → Get a quote from Relocations WA for international removals
<input type="checkbox"/>	Research storage providers if your move is temporary.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Organise overseas pet transport .
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sell belongings that you don't want to take with you.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Book flights.

One Month Before Moving Overseas Checklist

The next crucial time frame on your moving house spreadsheet is about a month prior to your relocation abroad. This should cover the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Notify key service providers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lawyer• Accountant, bookkeeper or financial advisor• Insurance service provider/s• Banks• Superannuation fund provider• Australian Taxation Office• The Electoral Commission• Car registration• Physicians, family dentist, medical specialists, therapists, veterinarian• Various utility companies, i.e., electricity, water and internet• Realtor• Australia Post• Local council and other councils in areas where you have investment properties

Next on your moving overseas checklist are the things you need to cover about a week before your scheduled move.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Start packing.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Clean your house.
